1. RAO Returns to Normal Schedule

The Osan AB Retiree Activities Office has returned to the normal schedule of 8am-3pm, Monday-Friday. The RAO now has enough office space to offer full services to retirees and widows. 2. Seoul Visit Schedule Reminder

The RAO visits Seoul on the second Tuesday of each month. Normally, we meet with retiree and widows from 0900-1200 in the Army Community Services on Yongsan South Post, Building 4106, Room 118. On April 12 and on August 9, the RAO will be in the Dragon Hill Lodge lobby from 0900-1200 because no space is available in ACS.

3. Change to Vehicle Decals

Widows who have registered their vehicle for a base decal will see a change when they register this year. The only decals they will receive are the safety inspection decal and the “USFK” decal. The safety inspection decal has a number on it that can be scanned, the same as the ID card is scanned and the vehicle information will be entered into BIDS when you register the car for the new decal. The “USFK” decal means that you will be able to drive your car onto any USFK installation in Korea.
