You will see some changes coming in September and October. In September, Jack Terwiel will take vacation from September 20 to September 29. During this time, he will not be available for assistance.

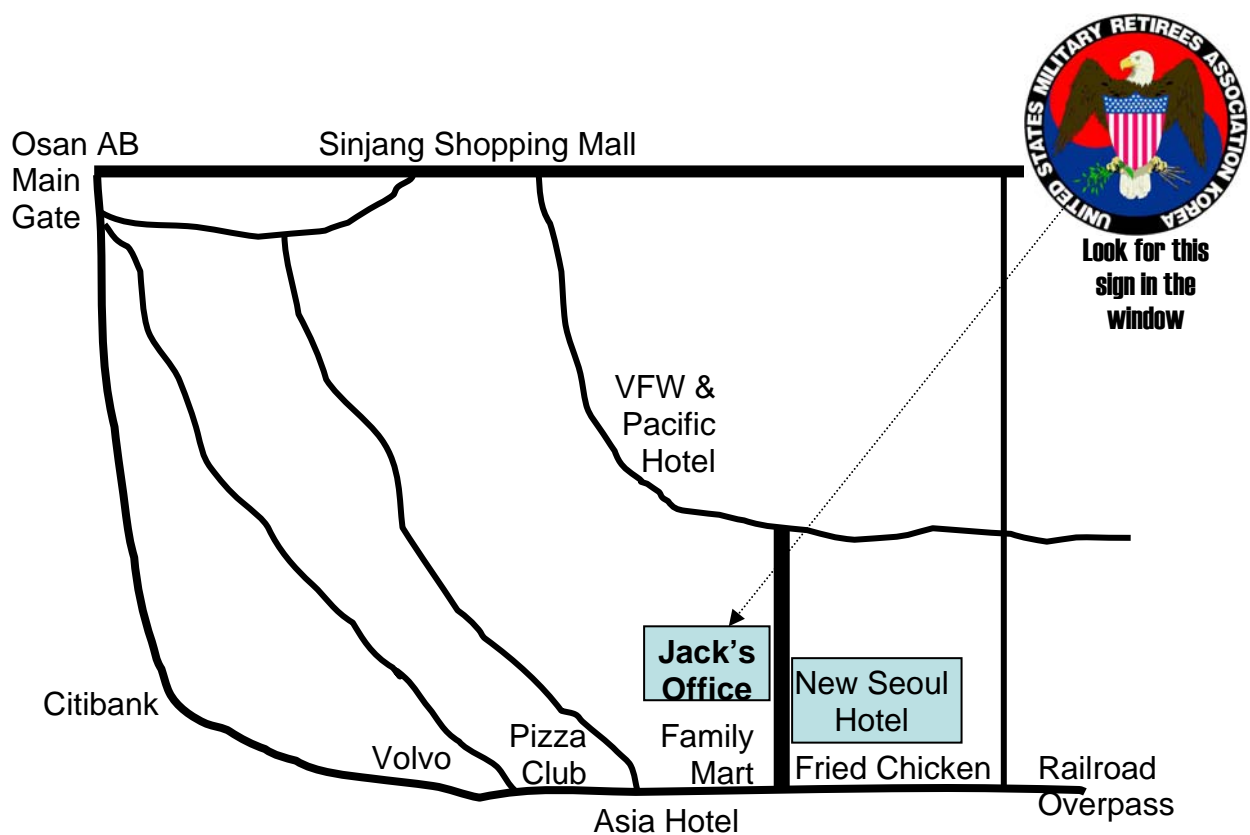
Starting October 2, he will be working at Yongsan in a new job, but doing the same thing he has been doing for almost 9 years. His new job is Army Retirement Services Officer for Korea. He will still be doing almost everything he has been doing for you. In some cases, because it's an official job, he will be able to do things more quickly. He is located in an office with military people and doesn't have a phone number yet. If you are familiar with where ID cards are issued at Yongsan, then you'll know how to find Jack. The temporary office is in Room 128 in the same building where the ID card section is located.

2. Downtown Songtan (Pyeongtaek) Office

We recognize that this move to Yongsan will mean that the Osan area retirees and widows will not have direct daily contact with Jack. To accommodate the people who live where we live, we are opening an office so that the retirees, and particularly the widows, who live in the Pyeongtaek area will have a place to go for assistance without the need to travel to Seoul.
